Container	Red		Beliy Naliv 7	Naliv means juice (or getting juicy). Most likely named after popular variety of apples in Russia. Container	Purple- Black		Black Sea Man 7	Small potato-leaf plants that yields abundant, rich mahogany tomatoes with olive green shoulders. Container/ Dwarf	Pink		Burpee's Dwarf Giant 3	Rugose leaf, bush-type plants producing oblate shaped, pink colored fruit that weigh up to about ten ounces. First fruits are the largest with the late season fruits considerably smaller. Introduced in 1909 by W. A. Burpee, from cross between 'Ponderosa' and 'Dwarf Champion'. Container/ Dwarf	Yellow		Burpee's Golden Dwarf Champion <b>7</b>	Sweet flavor. Heavy producer for a dwarf variety. Ideal tomato for small garden space.	Determinate 2 oz OP Late Season	Restoration Seeds
Container/ Dwarf	Green		Dwarf Beryl Beauty <b>4</b>	Dwarf (tree-type) plants with large, rugose, potato leaf foliage and a stout central stem. Round-oblata, smooth fruits that are a delightful pale-green with a yellowish blush when ripe. A pale-pink blossom end blush may develop on the fruit.
