








76		Arkansas Traveler	A 100 year old heirloom grown throughout the South, this vigorous plant yields abundant crops of round rose-pink tomatoes. Considered to be one of the best tasting tomato varieties with well-balanced sweet/tart flavors. Does well despite high heat, humidity or drought. Resistant to cracking and disease. 77		Big Boy	Producing large, deep-red, slicing tomatoes. Great for salads, canning, or juice. Robust plants are bred to thrive in a range of climates, providing a large harvest of fresh tomatoes throughout the season. Perfect for those looking to enjoy the tastes of summer all year round. 80		Captain Lucky	Green fruits streaked with bronze and red are sliced to reveal a kaleidoscopic marbled interior. The juicy half-pound beefsteak fruits are blemish free and have an amazing true summer tomato flavor: bright, deep, and sweet. 84		Eva Purple Ball	Delicious, round, blemish-free, pink-purple fruits. Purple tomatoes are generally rich in flavor and very popular among tomato gardeners. A good hot weather tomato variety.	Indet 70 days 2-3 in OP Mid-season	Seed Savers
85		Golden Queen, USDA	Yellow orange slicer. Also known as Livingston's Golden Queen which was released in 1882. USDA strain from back when the Department of Agriculture provided open pollinated seeds to farmers. Trellis for best results, thin skin.	Indet 70-80 days 10 oz OP	Restoration Seeds
86		Golden Sunray	Plant produces heavy yields of tomatoes that are very sweet, meaty and very flavorful. Perfect for salads, slicing, sandwiches, and for making sauces. 88		Jubilee	Like sunshine in the garden, this tomato is bright and golden with firm texture. Mild, low-acid flavor makes excellent tomato juice, sauce, and salsa. Expect high yields of these 3" delights. 1943 All-America Selections award winner. Disease resistant.	Indet 75-80 days 3 in	
89		Lida Ukrainian	Brought to America by Ukrainian immigrants prior to the 1920's. An heirloom producing meaty, long-lasting fruit with delicious, robust, well-balanced, old-time tomatoey flavors. A winner!	Indet 75 days 4-6 oz OP Mid-Season	Restoration Seeds

92		Paul Robeson	Russian variety named for the famous black opera singer. Paul Robeson, an American, was also a Russian Equal Rights Advocate for Blacks. Red-brick colored tomato has an amazing and distinct flavor that is sweet and smoky.	Indet 90 days 7-10 oz is a	Baker Creak
93		Rose De Berne	Resembles an apple in shape and red pink color. The Brandywine of Europe, flavorful tomato in France, Germany and Switzerland, named for the Swiss capital. Blemish free skin, good early production for market.	Indet 75 days 8-14 oz OP Mid-Season	Restoration Seeds
94		Rutgers	Fruits are bright red, medium large, smooth, globe shaped with thick walls and good interior color. Vigorous and prolific. Very popular.	Determinate 73 days 8 oz OP	American Seed

100		Tiger Paw	Pale yellow with pink blush, lightly lobed, flattened fruit (shape and markings like a cat's paw) with thin skin and delicious tropical-sweet flavors with a distinct hint of citrus.	Indet 77 Days OP Mid Season	Tomatofest
101		Trophy	Produces a good amounts of medium-sized, four to twelve ounce, flattened-globe to oblate shaped fruits that are firm & solid but also juicy, and mildly sweet. A good variety for processing and fresh slicing.	Indet 95 days 4-12 oz OP Late Season	Restoration Seeds
102		Vintage Wine	Potato leaf plant produces abundant crops of pink with gold-striped, pastel-hued, slightly flattened tomatoes with pronounced, elegant sweet delicious flavor.
