


<b>111</b>		<b>Rosalita</b>	Vigorous tomato plants that yield abundant crops of beautiful, rosy pink, oval, tomatoes in long, full clusters. A delightful new choice for anyone who likes grape tomatoes. These are sweet with pink color speckled all over with tiny white dots that give them an iridescent glow.
